

Navarre Raiders Quarterback Club Meeting Minutes (August 22, 2006)

Meeting was called to order by President Jeff Rodewald at 7:05 P.M. 28 members were present in addition to Coach Olson.

President's Report

- Nothing significant since last week; just ready for the season!

Secretary's Report

- Minutes from previous meeting were approved (unanimously) with one change to previous minutes: Sharon Brainerd will be taking pictures for the scrapbooks for seniors, not producing the whole thing as previously indicated.

Treasurer's Report

- Current balances in accounts were covered and total balance now stands at \$22,968.32; \$5,642.99 belongs to the Moms' Club and will go towards the pirate run-through.
- The QB Club made approximately \$1,600 from concessions at Meet the Raiders Night.
- Report was approved (unanimously)

Membership Committee Report

- Membership now up to 121 (from 113 one week ago) with the addition of 7 new members from Meet the Raiders Night and one new member at the meeting.
- Shirts are ordered for newest members.

Corporate Sponsorship Report

- \$200 more was reported received this week.
- Signs are up for all but one sponsor and it should be up on Thursday.

Concessions Committee Report

- Ice machine is making a lot of noise and blowing hot air; Pepsi coming to fix it.
- Potential "work-arounds" identified in the event the ice machine is not operational.
- New French fry cooker works great.

- Ready for the season; nothing new to report.

Merchandise Committee Report

- Nothing to report.

Stadium Committee Report

- Concrete slab poured for gazebo.

Moms' Club

- Signs still available.

Coach Olson

- Game Thursday for the Freshmen is at Woodham against West Florida Tech
- Winn Dixie is providing food for the team; there are a total of 91 meals required, of which 90 have been ordered

Spirit Week

- It has been announced at the local schools.
- Booths do NOT have to be open the entire week and it is up to each organization to determine how many days they want.
- The QB Club is providing all concessions.
- Pumpkin carving contest has been cancelled due to concern of kids with knives; potential solutions such as colored markers and bringing pre-carved jack-o-lanterns for judging.

Old Business

- The Gator cart price for a nonprofit organization (school) would cost \$4,900 and not the estimate of \$6,500; potential for a bank loan was discussed; another option discussed was a lease that would be \$200 per month with a minimum 5 month lease required; Coach Olson recommended we hold off on this requirement due to cost and other higher priority items needed; additional discussion focused on NYSA's Gators and the cost of upkeep, storage, theft, etc.; decision to table until another date.

New Business

- Motion made seconded to purchase senior flags to hang on the fence at the team entry area on the field; they are 2' x 2'; cost of \$726 would be split between the Moms' Club and the QB Club; end of season they would be presented as gifts to the seniors; approved (unanimous).
- Offensive and Defensive Line Coaches need headsets; reasons and needs discussed; motion made to purchase two new headsets for estimated \$1,350 total; approved (unanimous).
- Audio/Visual needs VHS players/recorders; old ones are desired as donations; if you have one at your home that is no longer needed, they'll take it.
- Next year Audio/Visual needs a new DVD camera/recorder system; it will also prove DVDs to recruiters; Coach Olson described the desired one at a cost of \$2,800 that has a combination camera, DVD/VHS, triple DVD burner, and a wired (not wireless) remote; Coach needs the wired remote to review game films with the team and not require him to stand in a direct line with the system
