

## **Navarre Raiders Quarterback Club Meeting Minutes (August 8, 2006)**

Meeting was called to order by President Jeff Rodewald at 7:05 P.M. 34 members were present in addition to Coach Olson.

### **President's Report**

- Stadium seats are due to come in on Thursday; installation will be on Saturday and Sunday if they arrive on time

### **Secretary's Report**

- Minutes from previous meeting were approved (unanimously)

### **Treasurer's Report**

- Current balances in accounts were covered and total balance now stands at \$18,567.57; just over \$4,000 of that balance belongs to the Moms' Club
- Report was approved (unanimously)

### **Membership Committee Report**

- Membership now up to 104

### **Stadium Committee Report**

- Three sections on home side now have painting completed: remaining two sections to be painted solid maroon and solid black respectively
- Gazebo plans now awaiting architectural approval
- Run through blower will be shipped this Wednesday; run through itself will be shipped next Monday
- Coach Olson informed the QB Club that advertisements in the end zones are now permitted in Florida;
- Coach also informed the QB Club that there will be a six foot "safety zone" around the entire field this year for all Florida games; it will be indicated by a dashed line and will include down markers and the chain gang
- Stencils for the end zone lettering measure 16' x 16' and will spell out NAVARRE in both end zones; possible to put the letter "N" at midfield as well
- Possibility of 4' x 4' pirate stencils for the 20 yard lines was discussed

### **Corporate Sponsorship Report**

- \$13,200 was reported received by the committee chair; QB Club president indicated that he had just received an additional \$3,100 on top of that figure

### **50 - 50 Committee Report**

- Tickets have been printed and are ready for the season
- New aprons are also available

### **Concessions Committee Report**

- President Jeff Rodewald summarized the renovations to the concessions stand; we now have two duplicate sides, with duplicate work stations, coolers, shelves, etc.;

- the front wooden counter has been removed and placed in the rear of the facility to allow additional counter workspace and free up the front so that servers can reach the concrete serving area
- A pretzel warmer machine (\$300), two chili servers (\$300 each = \$600), and a Sno Cone machine (\$700) are needed; motion made and seconded to authorize up to \$1,700 to purchase these items; motion carried (unanimous)

### **Coach Olson**

- “Football 101” will be held free of charge on Thursday night at 6:30 for all interested in learning the basics about football
- Meet the Raiders Night will be held August 17<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with the school’s Open House; start time of Open House is 5:30 PM and expected to last until about 6:50; the football teams, cheerleaders and band will all be present; great time for parents to get photos
- There will be a scrimmage this Friday; game time is 6:30 PM
- The Kickoff Classic at Pace will begin at 7:00 PM; the Freshmen will play the first quarter, the JV the second quarter, and the Varsity the entire second half
- The idea of collecting Campbell’s Coupons for purchasing equipment was discussed as it was reported that an 18 passenger van was purchased by one school; researching the validity, requirements, etc.
- We may need someone to run the 25 second clock for the scrimmage

### **Cheerleaders**

- Request was made for the boosters to pay for half the cost of shoes and half the cost of pom-poms; total cost of both would be \$4,486, so the boosters would pay \$2,243; these go to the entire three squads
- Looking for invoice/information on 8 megaphones for the 8 senior cheerleaders
- Current balance in funds is \$1,257

### **Old Business**

- Last minute additions to parent ads in the football programs are being accepted and Mike Householder will talk to the printer about getting them added
- Tina Harton is looking for a lot of volunteers to assist with Spirit Week planning; plan is for a Spirit Week leading up to the Gulf Breeze game; dates are Sunday October 22 through Thursday the 27<sup>th</sup>; intent is to give back to the community and build community, school, team spirit for the game; Sunday through Thursday would have games, entertainment, organizational fundraisers open to the community, and finish off Thursday night with a bonfire; QB Club would sell all food items; possible Punt, pas and Kick competition for all ages, “battle of the Bands” for local kids/groups, etc discussed; details/approval in working stages; see Tina for more details and to volunteer
- Recommendation made that a QB Club member should belong to the Navarre Chamber of Commerce; motion made and seconded; approved (unanimous); President Rodewald will attend/join (cost \$75)

## **New Business**

- Sharon Brainerd has volunteered to put scrapbooks together for all graduating seniors (22 boys and 8 cheerleaders = 30 total); she'll get in free to the games; motion made and seconded; approved (unanimous)
- New grill for concessions was purchased for \$399 and leaves a balance of \$601 from the approved funds; request was made to use that balance for two new deep fryers for french fries (safety concerns with old set); motion made and seconded; approved (unanimous)

## **Moms' Club**

- Yard signs still available for parents to purchase and place in their yards; signs have player's name, number, NHS, football logo, and a skull and crossbones; contact Tammy Rodewald or any other Moms' Club member to order (\$20)
- Football calendars are for sale
- Post game meals have all been secured, plus an additional \$50 from Wal Mart
