Secretary's Report

Banquet

Cheerleading

- 2 additional scrapbooks requested for the graduating mascots
- Cheerleaders will be selling cookbooks as a fundraiser; recipes being solicited; student personal pages may also be purchased for placement in the cookbooks (with photo \$45; without photo \$35); preordering cookbooks is also being offered; also looking for business sponsors; various sizes for ads; table will be at the banquet

Coach Olson

- Discussed guest speaker from Andrews Institute for banquet

Old Business

- Only remaining item from last year's meetings was purchase of a "gator" for the coaching staff; Jeff Rodewald stated that he has a lead with the new WalMart
