New district has been formed for 4A schools and ours will be a 9 team district with 4 schools moving into the playoffs at the end of the season; this means 8 of our 10 games in 2009 will be district games; Choctawhatchee is moving down to 3A due to loss of students; our district will include Pace, Milton, Ft Walton Beach, Crestview, Pine Forrest, Escambia, Tate, Washington (?), and Navarre
