New Business:

- Request to add upcoming 8th grade parents to QBC at a reduced rate. Tabled as bylaws need to be addressed on this subject.
- McMasters is working on meal card for members and requested the following prices:
- Home Games (5) possible – may change as we have appealed to move to District 1
- Membership – Meal fees total approximately \$3 per sandwich, side and drink
- Parking pass is limited to one car per family at home games – other vehicles pay
- Parking will remain \$2
- Football tickets will go up \$1.
- There will be no designation for QBC parking; rules need to be established on pickup and drop-off points; Coach deliver request for Mr. Murphy and Principal Nowak to make arrangements with band boosters for drop-offs in the horseshoe area near front office.
- Seats will cost \$30 and go up to \$35 next year. Between seats and members, we should clear pure profit. Bylaws need to be readdressed on the Row #7 through #10 seats and the expectations of future use. The request to revise bylaws will be tabled until April meeting. Revision includes seats designated for corporate sponsors that are free along with paid admission into the game. (approximate value \$120)
