- Not available; Jeff shared that the goalposts were pressure washed and primed before painting; high lift that was to be donated for our use was no longer available due to hurricane relief efforts; extension ladders used
- New streamers for the tops of the goalposts were purchased

- Newest logo for midfield was tested over behind the grill zone; new logo is a Raider flag like the one on our helmets; concern that the material won't last more than a year; recommended we look into tarp or plywood and make a stencil from the existing one

- Concession stand was inspected by the Health department and had the fewest deficiencies on record; all fixes will be minimal
- Varsity parents are still needed to sign up to work at JV and Freshmen games; a letter is being drafted for Coach's signature informing varsity parents that they are required to work one home JV/Freshmen game; there are only four and the concessions only need half of a normal crew, so sign up now!
