

## Navarre Raiders Quarterback Club Meeting Minutes August 9th, 2011

Meeting called to order by President Jeff Jones at 7:03 P.M. 29 members and 5 non-members present. (See all information at the QB Club website at nrqbc.org)

**Secretary's Report:** (Mike Householder, cell: 598-0064)

- Previous minutes were read and approved with one change: the hours for parking volunteers start time is 5:30, not as previously indicated (4:30)

- Schedule shirts will be available again this year; sale price is \$10 for players/cheerleaders, \$15 for all others; cost per shirt to QB Club is about \$8 due to two sided design
- Judy requested \$500 for an initial order of schedule shirts; motion made from the floor and seconded with a unanimous vote to approve; plan for shirts at first home game
- Judy needs manning for the merchandise table during games; also time to train her replacement
- Cups and hats available at Friday's picture day

- 50-50 to be conducted at Meet the Raiders Night
- Question came up as to what 50-50 actually is; for those who don't know, people buy raffle tickets at the varsity games and the winning ticket drawn at halftime with the winner getting half of the pot and the other half going to the QB Club; pots last year ran from \$300-\$500

- Need at least four folks per game and can still use more volunteers; shifts run from 5:30 until full (always before 7:30)
- Requesting signs for the parking area to explain the cost and identify the area as paid parking; cost at our games is \$2 and is the cheapest in the area; all schools charge and charge more
